



WORD FROM THE DEAN

I start writing this introduction of the PPE Yearbook with a profound sense of melancholy. The Yearbook offers us the faces and aspirations of this year's students, while these faces have vanished from our JS Mill College on the Fourth Floor for several weeks now. On a recent visit to the Fourth Floor, the place looked like a ghost palace, with Brian as its sole occupant working in complete isolation. Only the KallioPPE announcements, whose dates stop brusquely in March, are visible remnants of what once was a vibrant student community.

This

academic year has been a very remarkable year. I started my first opening speech in September, as new dean of the College, with the wish "May you live in interesting times." We witnessed interesting times indeed, which were the best of times and the worst of times. From a PPE perspective, the corona-crisis is mighty interesting. We are faced with a breakdown of the economic system, a closing of borders, a temporary suspension of basic civil liberties, and the price of a human life is being measured. Better decisions for a better world is what we need now. On the other hand, the year has been very hard for PPE students. The student community was scattered, lecturers had to improvise with online lectures, exams were rescheduled unpredictably, and second year students were in immense uncertainty about their foreign exchanges. Due to the lockdown students were confined in their rooms with a limited off-line social life, a situation that soon became horrendously boring.

This

makes this year's Yearbook very special. It connects again all the students who studied at the College and had only online contact in little clusters recently. And when you open this Yearbook again in future years, it will undoubtedly be a strange reminder of weird times and of the fellow students with whom you gone through them.
